Safety Measures

Morzine's local authorities have been working hard with accommodation owners, restaurants, bars, and activity providers, to ensure that all the necessary health and safety measures will be in place this summer. Holidaymakers will be able relax and unwind, while making the most of the vast Portes du Soleil region, with its wide-open spaces and fresh mountain air.

This winter Morzine was awarded the 'SafeGuard' label by the Bureau Veritas France. The label provides a guarantee that the resort respects the protective sanitary protocols put in place by the national authorities and those recommended by the World Health Organisation, while also ensuring appropriate training for resort workers.

In January 2019 Léo decided to fulfil his dream and create his own company, Pulse Activity. Sébastien Bron Goat farmer and guide

A mountain lover from his earliest years, it was natural for Sébastien to become a ski instructor and high mountain guide. He loves sharing his alpine stories with his clients and explaining how people live here. When he is not out in the mountains, he cares for his goats. For many years his parents worked the meadows in the Morzine area so it was completely natural for him and his partner, Anna, to take over the family goat farm. Using traditional methods, it's a job that allows him to share his passion and knowledge with his children, as well as with his clients. Holidaymakers can meet Sébastien at Ardoisières goat farm with its 60 resident goats and cheese making demonstrations.

Alice Passaquin-Marullaz The mountain at the end of her fingers

When visiting family in the Valais region of Switzerland, Alice became interested in the traditional Swiss craft of paper cutting. She has now been creating works for over 20 years and it has become her passion and career. The artform demands meticulous skill and patience, with each piece requiring a minimum of 10 hours of work. She gets her inspiration from her walks in the mountains and from closely observing nature and the flora and fauna. She is also inspired by her previous work as a Morzine ski instructor.

Dave Branfield A micro-brewery with a huge range of flavours

Having arrived in Morzine in 2011 and discovering there was no beer being brewed in the resort, Dave started brewing at home and then began selling his first bottles of beer in a restaurant in Montriond in 2014. The choice of the name IbeX is no coincidence either - not only is it short and easy to pronounce in many languages, it is also the family name of the wild goat. Today his range comprises four year-round beers plus summer and winter beers, all with unique flavours born of the combination of malt and local spring water from Morzine. Throughout the seasons, he offers other even more explosively flavoursome limited availability beers.

Morzine goes green

- new - Flocon Vert

Morzine has launched a bid to attain the Flocon Vert label. The accolade, which is awarded by the European organisation Mountain Riders, recognises destinations that demonstrate a commitment to a sustainable development policy. The label is issued based on compliance with 20 criteria divided into four themes: local economy, social & cultural, governance & destination, and environment & natural resources. Local businesses, the Tourist Office and Town hall are all working to reduce the environmental impact caused by residents, visitors and businesses in the resort. Their goal is to encourage everyone to get involved, by providing all the information needed to help people be greener and to make environmentally friendly options more accessible.

At the heart of Morzine's plans are local wildlife and nature.

- To protect birds, all the cables on lifts are being equipped with 'visualisers' every 5m, meaning fewer bird collisions.
- €20000 has been invested in 2 protected areas for black grouse.
- In collaboration with the ONF (Forestry commission): for every tree that is cut down on the ski area, another is planted, ensuring local pines, larch and spruce remain abundant.
- An awareness campaign around the problem of rubbish abandoned in the mountains will be put into place on the lifts.

Learn about mountain traditions and wildlife!

Morzine believes that in order to protect our environment; we must first better understand it! This summer a new informative wildlife trail will be put into place on the Nyon area: an easy hour long walk with lots of information panels about the local wildlife. Situated next to this trail, the Pointe de Nyon restaurant will have a new pastoral concept, with demonstrations on the work of mountain shepherds.

It's easy to add on a visit to the brand new "Pas de l'Aigle": a viewing platform at over 2000 metres altitude with a 350m vertical drop below, to see the immensity of the mountains and understand the need to protect our wild spaces!

Trail des Hauts Forts: a local eco-friendly trail 7th August 2021

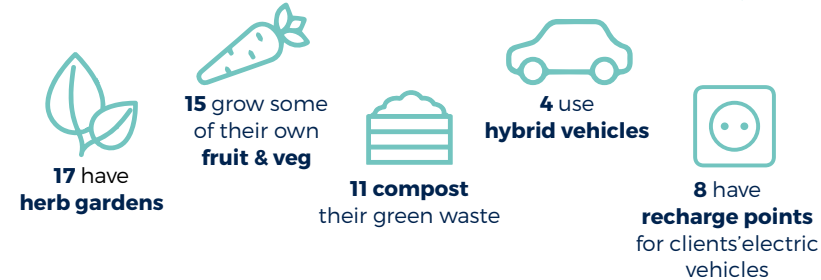
The Trail des Hauts-Forts was one of the few races able to take place in 2020. A tough route with lots of climbing, plus exposed technical sections, it was made even tougher in 2020 by having to limit feed stations to water only for this 14th edition.

For 2021, an environmental charter has been put into place to ensure a greener event and to reduce waste. It will continue to evolve, but always with the aim of limiting the impact of the event on the environment.

The main focus is the use of local producers for all needs, to both limit effects of transport and to support the local economy. This means local suppliers for feed stations, rescue services, technical needs, partners...

Numerous local businesses have introduced sustainable initiatives



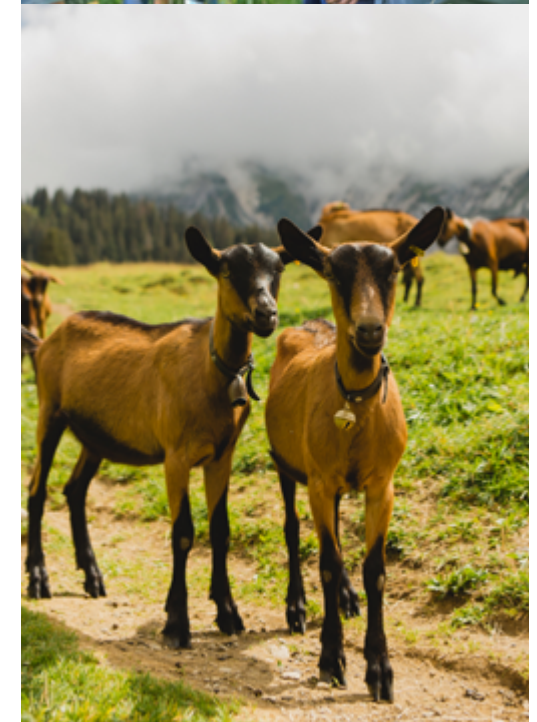

Canyoning

With a vertigo inducing start abseiling 45m off a bridge, it's adrenaline filled from the start!

This is a half day activity in the magnificent canyon, just 2km from the centre of Morzine. It's available every day, morning or afternoon from the 1st of July to 31st of August (1st June to 30 September on reservation). Several guides in Morzine-Avoriaz offer this activity.

Cycling

The legendary climb up to the Col de la Joux Verte is a route not to be missed by cycling enthusiasts this summer. The picturesque, shady road from Lake Montriond up to Les Lindarets winds through forest and allows cyclists to pass through the "goat village". The trip is 15km in total up to Avoriaz at 1800m altitude, followed by a beautiful descent to complete the loop back to Morzine.

A great alternative to mountain biking is the All Terrain Scooter! This summer everyone can tear down the side of the Pléney on an easy to ride off-road scooter. Just as in winter, the lifts give easy access to the top of the mountain. The sessions last 2h30 in groups of four, which enables everyone to go at their own speed while the instructor can look after each rider. Available to everyone aged 12 or over.

Parcours Aventure eXtrême

The unique new high ropes obstacle course hangs underneath the Super Morzine Bridge, 35m above the Dranse River providing impressive views of the valley. Adventurers traverse nets, beams, steps, tightrope cables and pendulums before taking an adrenaline-fueled zip-line journey back to the start.

Trout fishing at Nyon

Tyro-ferrata

A unique experience that sees thrill-seekers using a zip-line to fly above the Nyon Canyon and waterfall! This adventure enables guests to fly above the river and waterfalls before descending towards the canyon. It's a circuit of six long zip wires with a total of 400m of cable across the canyon. This circuit can be taken on with or without the classic high roped route, and can be done as many times as you like. Cheese and hike at the Fréterolles alpine meadow

Organised by the bureau des guides, this hike gives visitors to Morzine the opportunity to learn about regional traditions and to taste local produce. It begins with an easy trail that leads up through the woods to the Fréterolles Farm, where you'll find Abundance cows, pigs, goats and more. Then visit the cheese making laboratory to see how they turn milk into cheese, before tasting the products. There is also the opportunity to buy local produce, including the famously delicious Tomme de Morzine cheese, meaning you can take a taste of the mountains back home.

Mountain Bivouac

Local guide Hervé LeSobre offers everyone the chance to disconnect from modern life and reconnect with the great outdoors by spending a night in the mountains under the stars. Leaving late afternoon (5pm) in a small group, hike under the setting sun to a secluded spot with an expert guide before setting up camp. It's then time to collect wood for the fire, set up the hammocks between the trees, and spend an evening round the barbeque telling tall tales...

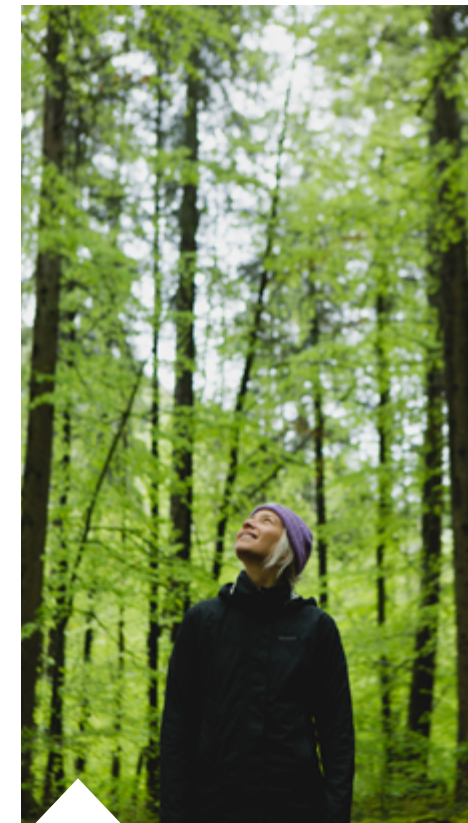
Forest bathing with Morzine Mountain Cooperative

There is a new wellness activity on offer, which draws on the Japanese practice of Shinrin-yoku. Literally meaning 'forest bathing', it is a form of natural therapy, which despite the name, does not involve getting into water. Devised by the wilderness expert Simone Simpson, the half-day experience is designed to help participants stimulate their five senses, through special breathing, walking, and listening techniques, while enjoying their forest surroundings. Comparable to a form of meditation, the excursion instils holidaymakers with the skills they need to practice the art-form anywhere.

Top American brand Santa Cruz Bicycles chose Morzine for its first European HQ in 2016 with an 80m2 showroom and has since gone on to help develop local trails and regularly host biking events in the village. The company picked Morzine because of its world class MTB offering and its status as the must-ride destination in Europe, with riders from across the world flocking to the resort, and now the Santa Cruz Syndicate race team is also based here in summer. If you visit, don't miss the opportunity to see Greg Minaar's 2013 World Championship winning bike. Greg, who has a second home in Morzine, is the only male racer with more than 20 DH world cup victories and 3 world championship victories. He's often found on his favourite Pléney trails with the coach Steve Peat (who has 53 world cup podiums to his name!), and their team mate Luca Shaw.

Thanks to the work by the resort and Santa Cruz Bicycles, in 2020 Morzine was voted the best Bike Park in Europe and eighth in the world by the readers of Vital MTB, one of the biggest American MTB websites.

Free to use, riders can learn how to tackle any natural obstacles that they may come across on the local trails including roots, ruts, berms, jumps and uneven ground.
